



KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Welcome to PTE! We're so excited that you're joining us in our 50th Anniversary season. Please take a moment to give this a quick read-through before your performance.

Curtain Time

All evening performances begin at 7:30pm. All matinee performances begin at 2:00pm. It's a good idea to arrive a bit early for the performance, especially if you're picking your tickets up at the Box Office. It also gives you time to find parking. **Aim for 20-30 minutes before the show starts** – you'll find the Lounge open for beverages.

Getting into PTE - Driving

PTE subscribers: always use your parking pass, leaving it on the dash. It covers Jets game parking as well as regular times.

Regular ticket holders: Parking in the Portage Place parkade offers the most convenience. Take **Elevator 6** (near the Carlton Street parkade entrance, formerly Elevator A) up to the 3rd floor. **You must pay for parking before coming up. If it's a Jets game day**, use the **code 2003** to reduce the price of parking from \$18 down to \$8.

The Portage Place parkade now accepts payment through a variety of parking apps – you'll find a sign listing them near the kiosks at the elevator lobbies in the parkade. Using an app means you don't have to stand in line for the kiosk. **If it's a Jets game day, you can ONLY get your discount at the pay machine.**

Getting into PTE – Walking or Bussing

You will need to enter the mall using the Edmonton Street doors at Portage Avenue (**the Edmonton doors at The Promenade behind the mall remain closed**). You will be able to use either the escalators or the elevator to reach the 3rd floor.

Note: there are two sets of doors to enter the mall from Portage Avenue at Edmonton – only one set will be unlocked, usually the set on the left-hand side. If you have trouble getting in, call 204-942-5483.

COVID-19 Precautions

We do not require proof of vaccination, and masks are not mandatory. **However, to keep our actors safe, we strongly encourage you to wear a mask while in the theatre.**
