Just before writing this, I watched a rehearsal hall run-through of Keith Barker's *Raised by Women*. PTE's rehearsal hall is an ordinary space: a big open room, a few tables and chairs, coffee station, a bulletin board. During a rehearsal, there are no theatre lights, music, sound effects, or setting. It's just an actor, telling a story.

Some plays need the "extras" to make an impact. Others can blossom with an actor alone in the act of storytelling. Which is why in a rehearsal hall run-through of *Raised by Women*, I still had the "full-meal deal" of great theatre. I laughed out loud and shed a few tears as Keith spun his beautiful stories of the women who raised him, and the man who didn't. Even before adding the stunning metaphor of Daina Leitold's set, or the atmospheric contributions of lighting, projections and sound by jaymez and MJ Dandeneau, Keith and director Matthew Paris-Irvine have created a heartwarming, funny, and thoughtful piece of theatre that I know you will love.

Speaking of spaces at PTE - our facility is bustling! In addition to our programming, we play host to many other companies and events — this spring we welcome hundreds of artists rehearsing shows for Theatre Projects Manitoba, Rainbow Stage, Dry Cold, Sick & Twisted, Winnipeg Jewish Theatre, Shakespeare in the Ruins, Winnipeg International Burlesque Festival, and the Winnipeg Fringe Festival. It is inspiring to share our space with so many great artists.

DIRECTOR'S NOTES

"I keep learning the lessons I need to learn until I learn them."

- Keith Barker in Raised by Women

While preparing to direct Keith Barker's world premiere of *Raised by Women*, I found myself coming back again and again to this nugget of wisdom.

It's simple.

It's honest.

It teaches us without judgement or vindication.

And, like all wisdom, it is imperfect.

That's the charm.

Keith's story about the women who raised him and the man who didn't is filled to the brim with these teachings. Knowledge from women who led their life from a place of grace, compassion, patience, joy, and understanding. Lessons learned, and mistakes made, while navigating the expectations of masculinity – and the naivete of being the 'nice guy'. Through humor, honesty, and his mother's grace, Keith shows us how to better hold the ones we love. How to forgive the ones that hurt us. That growth is anything but linear, and that being a good person is anything but absolute.

When I watch this play, I think about my mother, the strongest person I know. When you watch this play, I imagine you'll think about the strongest person YOU know. While Keith tells his story we'll be reminded together of stories just like his, of the long road towards becoming the best versions of ourselves, and of the mistakes we made because we are human. I hope we talk about it after. I hope we call that special person and tell them we love them. I hope we have the strength to forgive someone who needs it. I hope we remember the lessons, and that we keep learning them, until we learn them.

A year ago, my mom visited me in Stratford, Ontario. Over dinner she went quiet. "What's up, Mom?" She gave me a thoughtful look, "I don't know how you found theatre. Never in a million years could I have imagined this for you."

Me neither. When I finished high school, university just wasn't for me, and when my friends went off to chase their futures, I ended up in Thunder Bay without a plan. I wanted to be an actor, but I didn't know what that meant. I had no clear path, no role models to follow, and no guidance to rely on. When I moved to Toronto, all I had was a belief that I would find my way.

Tonight is another miracle in a long line of miracles that have come to define what 16-year-old Keith could not have imagined for his future.

In a time when I worry about our collective future, this play reminds me that we can't predict what is to come. The only way to face uncertainty is by responding with what matters most to us. For me, art and storytelling are at the heart of who we are. What a gift it is to be here to share this with you. Thank you for coming.

There are a million and a hundred and five people who helped to make this play a reality. Humbly, I stand on their shoulders tonight. Maarsi, Meegwetch, Merci, Thank-you.

Keith Barker is an award-winning Métis playwright, actor, and director originally from Northwestern Ontario. Keith is Director of the Foerster Bernstein New Play Development Program at the Stratford Festival, and the former Artistic Director at Native Earth Performing Arts in Toronto. Keith's other plays, The Hours That Remain, and This Is How We Got Here are both published through Playwright's Canada Press.


