Note:

Raised by Women is a one-person play, written and performed by Keith Barker. Keith tells stories about the way he grew up, raised by his single mother, and his relationship with his absent father. The stories bounce around in time – some are about when he was a child, some when he was a teenager and some as a young and older adult.

Content Warning:

There is a lot of humour in this play as Keith tells his story, but it also deals with serious matters including cancer, death, deadbeat dads, toxic masculinity, misogynist behaviors, and homophobia. There are discussions of violence which includes loud angry yelling on stage at times, mentions of domestic violence and the use of a BB gun against an animal.

Sensory Warning:

During the play the lights will rise and lower. There is soft music that is playing at intervals. At times during the play a bright street light lamp will turn on and off.
