Board appointments are typically for a three-year term, with options for renewal. Being a board member does not preclude you from working at PTE as an artist or technician or other capacities (administrative staff excluded).

PTE Board members are asked to support through the purchase of **seasonal subscriptions** and an **annual donation** that holds personal significance.
