Serving Elizabeth was developed in 2017 in the Thousand Islands Playhouse Playwrights Unit and was later co-commissioned with Western Canada Theatre. Both theatres funded a workshop in 2018. Serving Elizabeth received a world premiere in co-production between Western Canada Theatre and Thousand Islands Playhouse in 2020/2021.



Director's Notes

There's no way to talk about Queen Elizabeth without talking about the British Empire. Marcia Johnson's captivating play, which has had multiple productions in Canada and the US, draws us in through the famed TV series The Crown which was set against six decades of the British Empire. Serving Elizabeth, however, challenges our relationship to colonialism, affirms the right to tell our own stories, and includes an unlikely friendship between two women: one at the heart of British Imperialism and one from the Kenyan working class.

I love how this play jumps between stories and timelines, illuminating the parallels between characters and how the past informs their present. As the play's charming central figure Tia Mwangi embarks on "a grand adventure", she contends with her conflicting feelings about the Royal Family, authorship, and "selling out". Ultimately, she embraces the resister within and fights for her own story to be told.

Johnson's sparkling script delivers us dynamic, fierce characters, passionate debates, some classic historical figures and even a few cheeky belly laughs along the way!

It has been such an honour to be part of Ann Hodges' exciting season at PTE and a real privilege to work, play and imagine with this incredible cast and team. I hope you enjoy this play as much as we have working on it!



We create and gather on Treaty 1 Territory, the traditional lands of the Anishinaabeg (Ojibway), Ininewuk (Swampy Cree), Anishininewuk (Oji-cree), Dakota Oyate, and Dene peoples, and the homeland of the Red River Metis. As we gather to tell stories today, we so appreciate the original storytellers and stewards of this land.

Meet the Playwright

Marcia Johnson is an actor, writer, dramaturg and audiobook director/narrator based in T'karonto.

She originated the roles of Mercy and Patricia in Serving Elizabeth's world premiere at Western Canada Theatre (co-produced with Thousand Islands Playhouse) in February 2020. The TIP production was pandemic-delayed by a full year. Other productions played at the Stratford Festival, Belfry Theatre, Theatre Aquarius and New Hampshire's Peterborough Players. The podcast version is available on CBC Radio and PlayMe Podcast (Expect Theatre). The script is published by Scirocco Drama.

Other plays include *Binti's Journey* based on The Heaven Shop by Deborah Ellis, *Perfect on Paper* at the Toronto Fringe Festival and Talk is Free Theatre and *Say Ginger Ale* at the SummerWorks Festival. The latter two plays also had radio drama adaptations on CBC.

Marcia has performed in theatres including YES/Sudbury Theatre Centre (Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time); Blyth Festival (New Canadian Curling Club, 1837: The Farmers' Revolt) and Factory Theatre/GCTC (The Real McCoy). She performed in her ten-minute plays Get Out of Jail Free and Another Word for Single at the Port Hope Arts Festival and also makes brief appearances in TV and Film (American Gods, American Gothic, Diggstown). You can catch Marcia in two shorts making the festival circuit (The Comics by Veronika Gribanova and Memento Mori by Andrew Moodie and Emily Hurson).

Bola Aiyeola was born in Nigeria and moved to England. She immigrated to Canada as a young adult. Ava Darrach-Gagnon is a bilingual artist and graduate of the University of Winnipeg's Acting: Honours program. Theatre credits include *Little Women*, *Sense and Sensibility*, and *Unnecessary Farce* (Royal Manitoba Theatre Centre); *The*

Winter's Tale / Conte d'hiver (Shakespeare in the Ruins / Cercle Molière); and Joe Job (Imaginary Productions). Earlier this year, Ava was assistant director for Blue Beads & Blueberries (Manitoba Theatre for Young People) and will assist on Murder on the Orient Express (RMTC) and Tiny Beautiful Things (Prairie Theatre Exchange) later this season. She is thrilled to make her first appearance here at PTE.
