He's an alumnus of the legendary Second City Comedy Theatre in Toronto where he wrote and performed in six critically acclaimed revues, collecting multiple awards. He's the recipient of a Dora for his collaborative work in The Coal Mine Theatre's production of *The Wonder Pageant*. Matt is also an accomplished film actor and appears in the feature film *The Apprentice*. He was featured in the last season of *Supergirl* and the last season of *The Umbrella Academy*. He plays Doctor Robert Kaiko in the Netflix Limited Series, *Painkiller* starring Matthew Broderick, Detective Val Hardy in the Amazon series *Cross*, starring Aldis Hodge, Prosecutor Tom Radcliff in the *Matlock* pilot for CBS starring Kathy Bates, and Fraser in the Netflix series *Finding Her Edge*. Matt is currently hitting the stages as a story-teller and stand-up comic and tours to improvisational theatre festivals around the world.




