## KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

**Welcome to PTE!** Please take a moment to give this a quick readthrough before your performance.

### Curtain Time

All evening performances begin at 7:30pm. All matinee performances begin at 2:00pm. It's a good idea to arrive a bit early for the performance, especially if you're picking your tickets up at the Box Office. It also gives you time to find parking. **Aim for 20-30 minutes before the show starts** – you'll find the Lounge open for beverages an hour before the show starts. **You can also pre-order your drinks for intermission.**

### Getting into PTE – Driving or Cycling

**PTE subscribers:** always use your parking pass, leaving it on the dash. It's valid for all your performance dates, even when an event is on at Canada Life Centre.

**Regular ticket holders:** Parking in the Portage Place parkade offers the most convenience. Take **Elevator 6** up to the 3rd floor, or **Elevators 4 or 5** to the third floor and then follow the yellow line to reach PTE. [CLICK HERE TO SEE A MAP OF THE PARKADE.](#) **You must pay for parking before coming up to PTE.**

In addition to the machines in the parkade, you can use the ParkMobile parking app or the ParkMobile website. You can download the app from the usual app stores. Or scan the QR code at the machines and will take you to the website where you can pay for parking and check out as a guest – no need to create an account. Using either of those methods means you don't have to stand in line for the kiosk.

**If you are a single-ticket buyer attending a PTE show when there's an event or game at Canada Life Centre, you will be emailed an Access Code that will reduce the increased event parking fee of \$15 down to \$9, along with instructions on how to use it with the ParkMobile website (the discount is **not** available on the pay machine or app).**

PTE has a **permanent bike rack** just inside the lobby doors, available for all performances. It's advised that you bring a lock, but once the show has started, the lobby doors are locked for security. Enter through the main street level doors (see below for details).

### Getting into PTE – Walking, Bussing or Dropoff (taxi, Uber, Transit Plus)

The new main street level doors are located midway between Edmonton and Kennedy Streets on Portage Avenue. There's a sign reading "PORTAGE PLACE OFFICES" above the doors. **The doors lead into a spacious lobby for Elevators 4 & 5. Take either elevator to the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor and follow the yellow line to access PTE.** A security guard will be on duty in that main floor lobby area during PTE evening performances. A team from the **Downtown Community Safety Patrol** will be outside the doors, available for walks to your car or keeping an eye on the bus stop. **However, this door will be locked at 8 pm.**

The mall closes at 6 pm, which is when the only other street-level door, at Kennedy next to Shoppers Drug Mart, will be locked.
